PROGRAM NOTE:

Composed in 2003, *Epiphania for Nine Brass Instruments* is music about the manifestation of joy and hope in troubled times. The somber music intoned at the opening and closing of the work brackets a more joyous, hopeful dance of revelation and rebirth that incorporates jazzy rhythms and a direct reference to Paul Hindemith's *Symphonic Metamorphosis*. The brass choir comprises three trumpets, horn, three trombones, euphonium and tuba.
